The Okanagan Nation Alliance (ONA) is the tribal council for the seven Okanagan Nation bands which includes Osoyoos Indian Band, Upper Nicola Band, Upper Similkameen Indian Band, Lower Similkameen Indian Band, Penticton Indian Band, Westbank First Nation, and Okanagan Indian Band. The ONA's mandate is to advance, assert, support and preserve Okanagan Nation sovereignty. Further, the ONA is charged with providing members with a forum to discuss and form positions on areas of common concern.

The Okanagan Nation Alliance (ONA) is seeking to sub-contract a skilled and experienced individual to manage their Forests For Tomorrow (FFT) projects. The project manager will undertake duties associated with the ONA's FFT recipient agreement currently being implemented under Okanagan Nation Forestry Enterprises LLP. The successful applicant should be comfortable working in a fast-paced and dynamic environment, comfortable coordinating numerous field crews, be able to work independently and have excellent communication skills.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

As the FFT project manager you will be expected to carry out the following management activities:

- Liaison with First Nations, licensee's, contractors, sub-contractors, Price Waterhouse Coopers, and government officials
- Planning
